The permissions/notifications outlined in this form remain valid during the student's entire enrollment with Stanton Township Public Schools.

- Stanton Township Public Schools releases a student handbook each year. The parents/guardians are responsible for reading the handbook and ensuring that the rights and responsibilities pertaining to the students are understood and the parent/guardian agrees to support and abide by the rules, guidelines, procedures, and policies of the School District.
- Stanton Township Public Schools may record audio responses or to take pictures (including video) of student(s) to use in publications, presentations, the school newsletter, class projects, special programs such as the Christmas program, sporting events, assemblies, local media outlets, and to fulfill grant requirements/requests. Pictures may be used in printed publications and in electronic media, some of which may be maintained by organizations outside of Stanton Township Public Schools.
- Students may be transported for class field trips and school sponsored sports during the school year. I understand that my child will bring home communication about any field trips, which may or may not include additional written permission to attend. I can revoke my permission at any time by notifying the school office. I understand it is my responsibility to convey in writing if my child does not have permission to attend an upcoming trip or does not have permission to ride team buses.
- Stanton Township Public schools utilizes technology devices and internet usage throughout school programs. Students agree to follow the school's rules on using the internet. Users are expected to act in a responsible, ethical, and legal manner in accordance with our school's mission, code of conduct, and the laws of the United States. Students are responsible for any activities that take place with their user id. Students are subject to monitoring by the District Staff. Parents signing this form understand that the District may monitor pupil access to any of the interconnected systems. The Internet at the school is protected by site blockers set up by our local ISD. I do understand, however, that some material accessed by students may still be inappropriate for school-aged pupils. I agree to indemnify Stanton Township Public School District from any fees, expenses, or damages incurred as a result of my child's use or misuse of the Internet or equipment, and all claims arising out of or related to the usage our network.

Stanton Township Public Schools uses G Suite for Education and the school provides and manages a G Suite for Education account for your child. G Suite for Education is a set of education productivity tools from Google including Gmail, Calendar, Docs, Classroom, and more used by tens of millions of students and teachers around the world. At Stanton Township Public Schools students will use their G Suite accounts to complete assignments, communicate with their teachers, sign into their Chromebooks, and learn 21st century digital citizenship skills.

To review a complete copy of the G Suite for Education Notice to Parents and Guardians including what personal information Google collects, how Google uses that information, advertising, information that your child can share, and more by asking for a copy of the full notice from the school office. Signature of this form indicates your permission to provide and create a G Suite account for your child.

The District's Rules for Internet Acceptable Use / Computer / Computer Software / Copyrights are available in hard copy in the Principal's Office.

- Medications will only be administered to students if following the rules outlined below:
 1. All medications, nonprescription or prescription, have the appropriate forms completed by parents/guardians and the child's physician. Forms can be obtained from the school office.
 2. All medication must be safely delivered to the school in the original bottle marked with the student's (or family's) name. The parent assumes responsibility for the safe delivery of medication to school.
 3. Over the counter medications (Tylenol, Advil, Benadryl, Essential Oils, etc) will only be administered to students that have brought in their own supply and have the required forms completed. The District will not supply medications.
 4. The parent assumes the responsibility for requesting the correct paperwork and having it completed prior to the District administering any medication.
 5. The parent assumes the responsibility to notify the school immediately if there is any change in the use of medication.
 6. The parent/guardian release and agree to hold the Board of Education, its officials, and its employees harmless from any and all liability for damages or injury resulting directly or indirectly from this authorization.
