



## Section 98c Learning Loss Plan

Section 98c funds are available to local education agencies through Public Act 144 of 2022. Signed into law by Governor Gretchen Whitmer, the act appropriates \$52,056,000 for LEAs to address learning loss. At the time of the writing of our plan, the State of Michigan Department of Education is expected to allocate between \$36.50 and \$50.00 per student in funding directly related to learning loss. Stanton Township Public Schools anticipates a total allocation of approximately \$6,000 and possibly up to \$9,000.

Our district intends to use all grant proceeds to fund intensive after-school tutoring to assist students with core subject needs with an emphasis on math and ELA. These students will be identified in several ways, including identification through Acadience Benchmark Assessments, ongoing progress monitoring tools, classroom scores, teacher referrals, as well as parent and student requests.

After-school tutoring sessions will average 60 minutes in length and will be led by qualified staff. The effectiveness of this assistance will be measured by Acadience Benchmark Assessments in both ELA and math for grades K-6 and student scores on classroom assessments in grades 7-8.
